**Program Description:**

***“The Movement UBA Semi-Pro Basketball Summer Exhibition Game: Cincinnati Movement vs. Dayton Sharks”***

- For all ages, entry FREE
- Inviting everyone to come out and support Cincinnati’s only semi-pro basketball team, The Cincinnati Movement. They will play an exhibition game featuring another team in the Universal Basketball Association (UBA).
- This game will be played at night, under the lights, in a family friendly environment. Game will be played as such:
  - NBA clock – 4 quarters (12 minutes)
  - 1 hour pre-game warm-up beginning at 6:00pm
  - Halftime show 10 minutes

***“The Movement Fundamental Basketball Camp”***

- For ages Kindergarten to 12<sup>th</sup> grade, entry FREE
- Inviting all kids and parents to get elite training from our Movement Coaching Staff
- Geared towards all skill levels

***“The Movement Middle School/ High School 3-on-3 Tournament”***

- For grades 7<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> grade, entry FREE
- 5<sup>th</sup> Annual High School 3-on-3 Tournament. We welcome all high school players to come out and compete in a friendly, community-building tournament. Players can register as a team or players can register individually and we’ll place them on a team. Teams can consist of up to 4 players (1 as a substitute). Tournament is a 2 game minimum. Two tournament groups to compete in Freshman/Sophomore Bracket or Junior/Senior Bracket. Games winners are first to 21 (2 & 3 pointers) or 10 minutes. Referees will monitor games for excessive fouling and foul play. No violence, profanity, or foul play will be allowed during tournament play. Violators will be issued technical fouls leading to free throws. Excessive violators will be removed from the tournament.

***“The Movement Adult 3-on-3 Money Tournament - \$1000 Grand Prize”***

- For adults 18+ co-ed, entry fee \$100 per team
- We welcome all adults to come out and compete in a competitive tournament. Players can register as a team. Teams can consist of up to 4 players (1 as a substitute). Tournament is a one and done style tournament. Referees will monitor games for excessive fouling and foul play. No violence, profanity, or foul play will be allowed during tournament play. Violators will be issued technical fouls leading to free throws. Excessive violators will be removed from the tournament.

### **“Kids & Adult Open Recreation”**

- Kids and Adults of all ages can come and enjoy the sport of basketball. Basketballs will be available for free play. Raffle opportunities will be given out, along with competitive competitions for prizes.

- Confirmation of t-shirts for Movement Staff
- Equipment needed: 2x 6' tables, 6-8 chairs, access to electricity, 4 parking passes, 4 all access passes, Food vendor vouchers for staff for the weekend
